## Find resources that can enhance your teaching and supporting of learners.

Aimed particularly at teaching staff and those that support learners, the Resource Centre provides a wide range of evidence-based, practical resources that support good teaching and learning.

It contains the growing range of work Ako Aotearoa has produced and funded, as well as many other case studies, tools and reports from New Zealand and overseas.

Browse the content using the topics and disciplines taxonomy, or start with summary guides. Use the new Resource Centre search to pinpoint material that meets your needs.

## Join a group to get involved in discussing teaching and learning issues.

The website hosts a range of group spaces for project teams and communities of practice. These spaces allow members to collaborate by discussing and sharing ideas, project information and resources – in private or public.

The Groups landing page makes it easier for you to access project or community groups that interest you. You can do a Quick Search to find them, or browse according to topic or discipline.

## Find out what research is going on and who's doing it.

The website's Research Register is of particular interest to researchers and people applying to Ako Aotearoa for funding.

It provides a comprehensive list of current and recent New Zealand research and projects in tertiary education. Details provided include the names of the researchers, research objectives, methodology, and where possible links to outputs.

Improved search options make it easier for you to find projects of interest. Search by topic, discipline, keyword, researcher, project title, project status (completed or still in progress) or a combination of these.

## Other key features

- **Regional Hub pages** – find out what we are doing in your region via the quick links on our homepage to our three regional hubs – Northern, Central and Southern
- **Events** – on the homepage we list a wide range of events from across the tertiary sector
- **Site map** – providing additional navigational support, this site map feature appears on the bottom of the homepage and all pages across the site
- **Functionality** – registered users can bookmark favourite pages, use RSS feeds, and create email alerts
